GIBA LBG MEMBERSHIP & WINTER COMPETITION GUIDANCE NOTES

- LBG Note** At the April 2013 AGM it was agreed to setup GIBA LBG so that all existing companies merge (Holdings, Stadium & GIBA) so the bowlers own their club. An LBG is a company 'Limited by Guarantee', for non-profit organisations that have members who act as guarantors. The club will not hold any money, if the club gets into financial difficulties and decides to wind up they will collect the £1 from each member at the time. The Articles & Memorandum will be available on the GIBA LBG website.
- Note 1.** This league will play to 18 ends.
- Note 2.** This league will play to 16 ends.
- Note 3.** This league will play to 14 ends.
- Note 4.** This league may play some games on Tuesday if we can not accommodate the games on Monday due to the level of entries.
- Note 5.** New members, learners, or occasional players welcome. The precise format of this umbrella league will vary depending upon the number of players who turn up each week.
- Note 6.** Tuesday 2-4-2 Pairs will start at 7pm and be played to full open rules and be of 16 ends with no time limit.
- Note 7.** Wednesday Triples league will start at 7pm, be of 16 ends, no time limit.
- Note 8.** Thursday 3-Bowls Pairs league will start at 6.30 pm, be of 3 sets of 6 ends, no time limit, but restricted rules i.e. one visit, jack killed placed on side spot etc.
- Note 9.** Thursday Social Singles league will be at 8.40pm only and be of 2 sets of 7 ends with a 1 end tie break. If the end is killed the jack will be replaced on the nearest side spot. £10 entry fee provides prize money.
- Note 10.** The winners of the singles titles will qualify for their respective IIBC championships. Should the winners be unable to participate, the bowls committee will nominate alternative players. Games will be played to IIBC rules. The number of entries will determine the format.
- Note 11.** This competition is restricted to men and ladies who are Guernsey residents. The winners will play off against the Jersey winners in January and those winners will be invited to represent the Channel Islands in the British Isles Indoor Championships.
- Note 12.** The winners of the singles titles who are under 25 on 30th April 2023 will qualify for their respective IIBC Under 25 Championships in November / December 2023. Should the winners be unable to participate, the selection committee will nominate alternative players. Games will be played to IIBC rules.
- Note 13.** These competitions will be played to a 3 hour time limit with the jack placed on the relevant spot.
- Note 14.** In this competition, each player will have 3 bowls. The 3 closest bowls to the jack are counted, points awarded are 1st closest - 3 points, 2nd closest - 2 points & 3rd closest - 1 point. This is done for every end. Game to be played to 16 ends.
- Note 15.** This competition is open to all members who have been bowling for less than 5 years.
- Note 16.** This competition will be played as a pairs match, but with the winning team on each end scoring only one shot. Games will be three sets of seven ends, open rules.
- Note 17.** In this competition the leads play two bowls alternately and then the skips play two bowls alternately followed by the leads playing their remaining bowls and finally the skips.
