GIBA LBG MEMBERSHIP & WINTER COMPETITION GUIDANCE NOTES

- **LBG Note** At the April 2013 AGM it was agreed to setup GIBA LBG so that all existing companies merge (Holdings, Stadium & GIBA) so the bowlers own their club. An LBG is a company 'Limited by Guarantee', for non-profit organisations that have members who act as guarantors. The club will not hold any money, if the club gets into financial difficulties and decides to wind up they will collect the £1 from each member at the time. The Articles & Memorandum will be available on the GIBA LBG website.
- **Note 1.** This league will play to 16 ends.
- **Note 2.** New members, learners, or occasional players welcome. The precise format of this umbrella league will vary depending upon the number of players who turn up each week.
- **Note 3.** Tuesday 2-4-2 Pairs will start at 7pm and be played to full open rules save for if the jack is killed then it shall be respotted on the side spot and be of 16 ends with no time limit.
- **Note 4.** Wednesday Drawn Triples league will start at 7pm, be of 15 ends, no time limit. Teams will be drawn by Selection Committee for a league before Christmas and redrawn for a league after Christmas. Evey five ends players shall move up a position such that each player plays 5 ends in each position.
- **Note 5.** Thursday 3-Bowls Pairs league will start at 6.30 pm, be of 3 sets of 7 ends, no time limit, but restricted rules i.e. one visit, jack killed placed on side spot etc. Players may swap position after the completion of each set.
- **Note 6.** Thursday Social Singles league will be at 8.40pm and be of 2 sets of 7 ends with a 1 end tie break. If the end is killed the jack will be replaced on the nearest side spot. £10 entry fee provides prize money.
- **Note 7.** The winners of the singles titles will qualify for their respective IIBC championships. Should the winners be unable to participate, the bowls committee will nominate alternative players. Games will be played to IIBC rules. The number of entries will determine the format.
- **Note 8.** This competition is restricted to men and ladies who are Guernsey residents. The winners will play off against the Jersey winners in January and those winners will be invited to represent the Channel Islands in the British Isles Indoor Championships.
- **Note 9.** The winners of the singles titles who are 25 or under on 1st October 2026 will qualify for their respective IIBC Under 25 Championships in November / December 2026. Should the winners be unable to participate, the selection committee will nominate alternative players. Games will be played to IIBC rules.
- Note 10. These competitions will be played to a 3 hour time limit with the jack placed on the relevant respot.
- Note 11. In this competiton, each player will have 3 bowls. The 3 closest bowls to the jack are counted, points awarded are 1st closest 3 points, 2nd closest 2 points & 3rd closest 1 point. This is done for every end. Game to be played to 16 ends.
- **Note 12.** This competition is open to all members who have been bowling for less than 5 years. The 5 years includes junior play and historic play before a break of membership.
- **Note 13.** This competition will be played as a pairs match, but with the winning team on each end scoring only one shot. Games will be three sets of seven ends, open rules.
- **Note 14.** In this competition the leads play two bowls alternately and then the skips play two bowls alternately followed by the leads playing their remaining bowls and finally the skips.
